

Currency Tally Sheet Instructions, Version 4f from November 1, 2024

Instructions for Use

Thank-you for downloading the Currency Tally Sheet. It has been designed to make it easy to organize your currencies and present them in an organised way at your RV appointment. By entering the actual rates you receive at the exchange, you can easily determine how much money you will be receiving in relation to Dollars (USD), Pounds (GBP) and Euros (EUR).

Please read this manual so that you can make full use of this spreadsheet, which is suitable even for beginners, as no programming knowledge is required.

To prevent accidental overwriting of cells, not meant to be altered, we have locked the spreadsheet except for the cells that need changing. This is due to problems caused by some people deleting or altering cells that should not have been. If you must make changes, unlock the pages with "Cologne". We cannot support any changes made to the spreadsheet after unlocking it.

Preparations

- Open the Spreadsheet and make sure you have set the tab at the bottom left to "Bonds and Currencies".
- Obtain the latest exchange rates for all the currencies you own and update them.
- Make sure you have a printer connected to your computer and it is online.

Table 1: Updating the Exchange Rates

Go to Table 1 and update the exchange rates in column B, with the latest numbers available. By default, the rates given are estimates based on what is known at the time of release. There is no guarantee that these default rates are accurate and should be seen as a guide, only. The rates given here are referenced by the rest of the spreadsheet.

For example, if a Vietnamese Dong is worth \$20, then enter 20 in cell B17.

If the Iraqi Dinar is worth \$3.22, then enter 3.22 in field B15

(the sample value of \$28.50 is the rumoured contract rate we might receive).

Table 2: Defining Other Currencies

Although we have provided tables for most currencies involved in the RV, you might have one of the more unusual currencies and need to add them separately. We have predefined some sample currencies and you can change the currency names, rates and note sizes at will.

If you have currencies not listed in Table 1, enter the Currency. Rate and Denominations in Table 2

Denomination Currency: Enter the name of the currency. If you are defining more than one denomination, add that to this line. e.g. 200 Digitales (VED, 2024) Bolivar means the 200 Venezuelan Bolivar Digital note, issued in 2024 and added on user request.

1 Currency = USD?: This is for the exchange rate against the Dollar

Note Size in Numbers: The size on the note in numbers.

Description: This is for your notes on the respective currency. Write anything you like.

Each of these tables represents a different currency, otherwise they are filled in the same way.

Count the number of notes you have for each denomination and enter that number in column B under "# of Notes." That is all you need to enter; the rest of the table is filled in automatically.

In the above example, the following notes have been entered:

5x 5 Trillion \$ZIM, 4x 10 Trillion \$ZIM, 3x 20 Trillion \$ZIM, 2x 50 Trillion \$ZIM and 1x 100 Trillion \$ZIM

The Subtotal displays the total value of each note size in the respective currency (here \$Zim)

The "BSR Value" or "PNR Value" is the converted value in US Dollars.

BSR = Back Screen Rate, that is a possible contract rate that may be available.

PNR = Private Negotiable Rate, that is a possible rate you may be able to negotiate.

Fill in the respective number of banknotes for each currency. If you do not have any currency for a specific currency, just leave the respective # of notes at 0.

We also recommend entering the serial number details of each note in the special table in the Serial Numbers tab. See page 5 for details.

The totals for all currencies are shown on the next page.

The final page of this report lists each currency and their respective values in US Dollars, based on the exchange rates defined in tables 1 and 2. The total value of all currencies is shown in US Dollars, GB Pounds and Euros at the bottom of the table. This entire table is created automatically from the values in the other tables. You do not need to enter anything in this table. Double-check that everything has been entered correctly and then you can print the worksheet.

We also recommend you document the serial numbers of your currencies, as described on the next page. If you have a humanitarian project, you can nominate up to 8 people to go on a med-bed treatment, as described later in this document.

While every effort was made to create and check this spreadsheet, we accept no liability for errors or miscalculations. Use this spreadsheet entirely at your own risk. If you do find an error, please let us know.

To document the serial numbers of your banknotes, click on the Serial Numbers tab at the bottom left of your screen.

This is a simple spreadsheet where you can list all your currency including serial numbers, and where you bought them from.

Full Name of Owner: This is the person that owns the currency and is to benefit from the exchange

Currency: The name of the respective currency to be exchanged.

Serial Number: The serial numbers of each note you have. Iraqi Dinar writes these numbers

in Arabic, and you will find tools to help you convert them at

Face Value in words: The value of the note written out in words.

Bought from: The name of the vender you purchased them from.

Purch. Date: The date on the invoice when you purchased them.

Invoice #, Checked: The Invoice number from the vendor. After double checking all the details are

correct, you can confirm that here.

Price: The amount you paid to purchase the currency (optional)

When finished, simply print this worksheet.

We have been told that Zim-Bond holders with humanitarian projects can nominate 8 people for med-bed treatments. These people do not need to be associated with your project, yet we advise you include people vital for your project. The world needs a lot of healing and to achieve this, humanitarians with projects to help humanity and reduce the suffering of people, clean up the world, assist people in need, introduce innovations that improve the world, etc. are much needed, and for that, people with the ideas and willing to run such projects can be given the necessary funding they need to make things happen.

We have been told that those nominating a project will receive between \$33 and \$50 million dollars for their personal use, to remove the profit motive from the project, plus the funds you need to run your project, which are potentially unlimited.

You will need to create a project outline, to present at your meeting, that explains the purpose of your project in laymen's terms in approx. 5-10 minutes. You should also prepare a folder, with a more detailed business plan, that you can provide three copies of to leave with them when you submit your project.

As they want you to be able to focus fully on your project, and not be tied down helping sick relatives and friends, you can nominate eight people of your choosing to be given priority med-bed treatments. It is also possible to nominate animals as well.

Note: As you and your nominees will possibly be treated before Med-Beds are officially announced, you may be required to sign an NDA (Non-Disclosure Agreement) and then go on vacation away from people that know you until Med-Beds are publicly announced.

On this page, we are providing a form that you can use to provide details of yourself and the 8 people you are nominating. Please discuss and agree this with these people before you go for your treatment, as you will then be under an NDA and will no longer be able to talk about it.

You can then hand a printout of this page to the staff at the Med-bed center. They will then advise you further.



Nominee #: Give your relationship to the person (Spouse, Mother, Business partner, etc.)

Full Name: Give the full name of the respective patient

Address 1: Give the full street address (no Mailbox addresses)

Address 2: Optional additional address line.

Town: The town or city of the respective patient.

State/County: The State or County

Zip code: The Zip or postal code

Country: The country of the patient, e.g. USA, UK, Germany, etc.

Telephone: The telephone number the patient, or carer can be reached on.

Email: The email that can be used to reach the patient.

Age: The age of the patient in years.

Urgent (Y/N): If the patient is in a life and death situation, mark this with Yes

Medical issue #1: The most important medical issue that need treating

Medical issue #2: The 2nd most important medical issue that need treating

Medical issue #3: The 3rd most important medical issue that need treating

Medical issue #4: The 4th most important medical issue that need treating

Notes: At the bottom of page 2, you have space to add any relevant comments

Once complete, print this out and give it to the med bed center staff, after checking with the patients that they are happy to be nominated for a med bed treatment. The line length for nominee #8 is much longer, useful when more space is needed.
